

## ABOVE SOUNDS GAMES LIST

**HUGGIE BEAR:** When the DJ stops the music and calls out a number. The Crowd must get in a group of that number or get kicked off the dance floor!

**LIMBO STICK:** Two participants volunteer to help hold the stick and everyone else must go under it while the stick slowly gets closer to the floor. If you touch the stick or floor, you loose!

**BRIDAL TRAIN:** The Train starts behind the bride and she goes around the room until a train of people form and then she leads them back to the dance floor!

**MUSICAL KNEES:** Similar to Musical Chairs; however, the Chairs are replaced by the groomsmen. Then the bride maids dance until the music stops, and they must sit down. After each song, a man is removed until we have a winning couple. Then they dance!

**TOLIET PAPER GAME:** This is where two people (bride n groom) are sitting in chairs facing each other. Then two rolls of toilet paper are placed in front of them on a stick. The guys cheer for the man and the girls cheer for the lady. Whoever unravels the roll first wins control of the TV remote for a month!

**HOT POTATO BALL:** The Crowd forms a circle and passes the ball (or bouquet) around until the music stops. When it stops the person must leave the dance floor. The last person with the item wins!

**CHICKEN DANCE:** A Very popular dance where people form a circle and dance like a chicken!

**HOKEY POKEY:** A Great way to keep adults and kids involved. A circular dance where you stick parts of your body in and shake it about!

**TUNNEL OF LOVE:** Guests form two lines to the cake, and face each other and form an arm arch. The bride and groom go through and the tunnel collapses as the guest follow the bride and groom through the tunnel to the cake table.

**SOUL TRAIN LINE:** Party forms two lines on the dance floor, guys one side ladies other. They dance down the middle to funky music!

**PASS THE SPOON/BELL:** During dinner, the table chooses a spoon and passes it around. When the music stops the DJ tells the person that they win! (This is a center piece giveaway)

**TRIVIA QUESTION:** Two people (bride/groom) sit in a chair facing away from each other. DJ asks them questions and they write it on a paper with markers. Then they show the answers to the audience on how well they know each other. Example: "What is your wife's favorite TV show"

**CIRCLE OF FRIENDS:** The dance floor forms a circle with the bride and groom in the middle. A microphone is passed around and people say thanks to them!

**SUMMER NIGHTS:** A song off the Grease soundtrack where the guys and girls battle on the dance floor to see who is the loudest!

**SHOUT OUTS:** The DJ goes around to the tables during dinner with a microphone and guest say things to the bride and groom!

**LONGEST MARRIED COUPLE:** The DJ plays music and then stops. Then Couples leave the dance floor each time the music stops. The DJ calls out a number of years together each time to find out who is the longest married couple. The winner then says a few words of advice to the bride and groom and then they get a special dance together!

### YMCA

This is a dance by the Village People where the dance floor spells out YMCA with their arms and hands!

**THE TWIST:** A song popularized by Chubby Checker, everyone gets out to the dance floor and twists their bodies until their hips fall off! When the DJ says freeze they freeze!

**DJ SAYS:** Just like Simon says. The DJ tells contestants what to do "DJ SAYS..." if they do it when the DJ does not say they must leave the dance floor!

**KARAOKE:** Guest sing to their favorite songs while they read the lyrics on the screen.
